Created in 1978, the house of Europe is a non-profit-making organisation, in partnership with Dunkerque Grand Littoral Urban Community of Dunkerque, the French Federation of the Houses of Europe and the EUNET network (European Network for Education and Training for des Maisons de l'Europe). The Maison de l'Europe has become known as "Europe Direct" by the European Commission. In partnership with Dunkerque Grand Littoral.
